- 1. Briefly describe the field experience. What did you learn about technology facilitation and leadership from completing this field experience? An authentic and engaging ISTE Lesson Plan Project was created and implemented with first grade students. Students used various Web 2.0 resources like Padlet, Recite, and Shadow Puppet to create presentations addressing social issues in the school setting. I learned a lot about managing, planning and implementing an experience with students using Web 2.0 resources. The experience gave me practice with troubleshooting and differentiation and the mechanics of having student work hosted in a Web 2.0 environment. Through adhering to the lesson plan project guidelines of using multiple Web 2.0 resources, I discovered that Shadow Puppet and Padlet are a great combination for younger learners to archive their work on a class wiki/webpage. I will likely use the combination of those two resources in the future and hopefully be able to create a professional development in the future based on the successes I had during the project.
